Prior to the next public meeting, the project team plans to set up "Community Meetings" to discuss the alternatives with each community in the project area. Meetings are already scheduled with Reading and Lincoln Heights. 3. Possible relocation sites for the mobile display were discussed. The alternatives were reviewed by the IC committee members and questions were answered. Most questions pertained to the operational characteristics of the alternatives and how motorist would actually travel after the project was completed. There were some concerns regarding access changes as well as the acquisition of property. Most alternatives were generally well-received and many IC members said they needed more time to review before issuing a formal opinion. More detailed information regarding the alternatives will be presented at individual community meetings and at the Public meeting.
