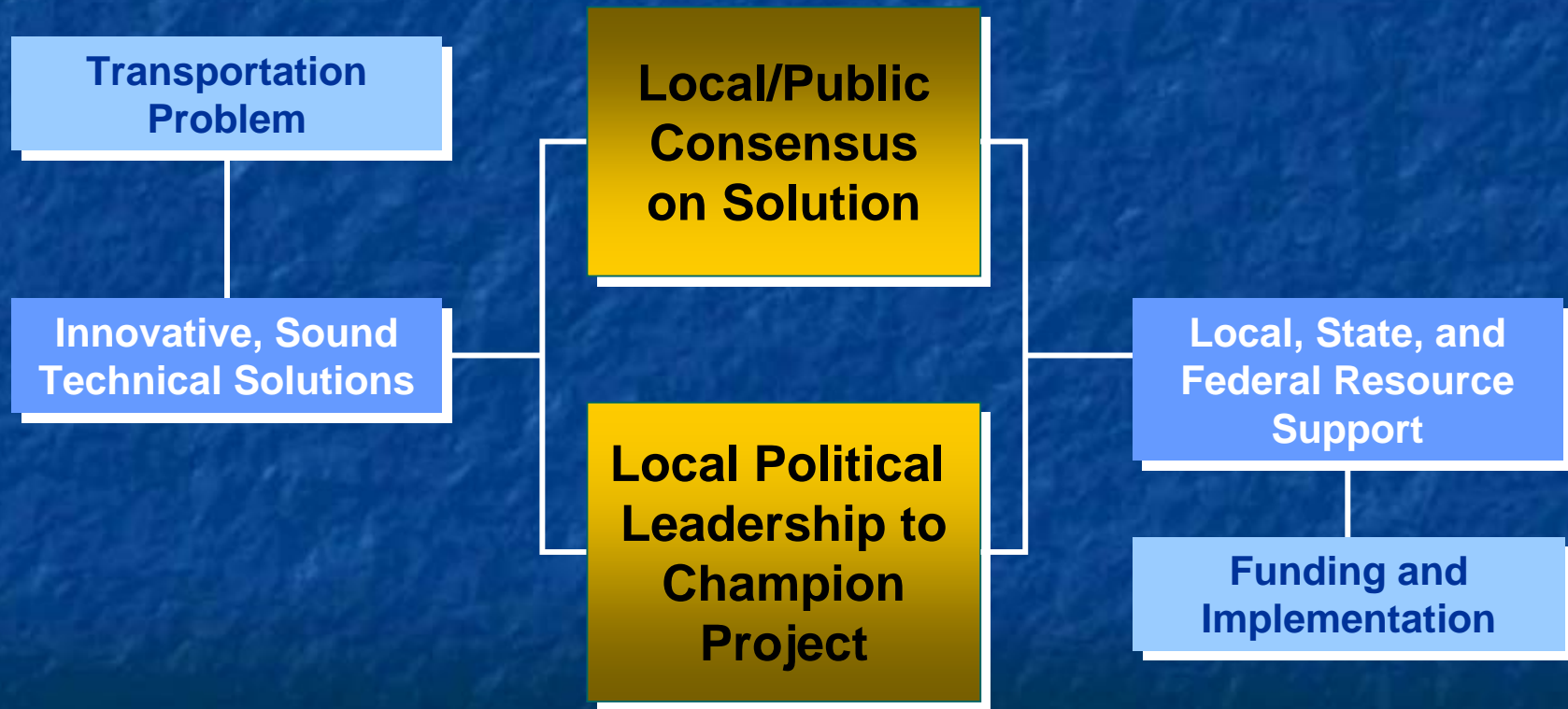

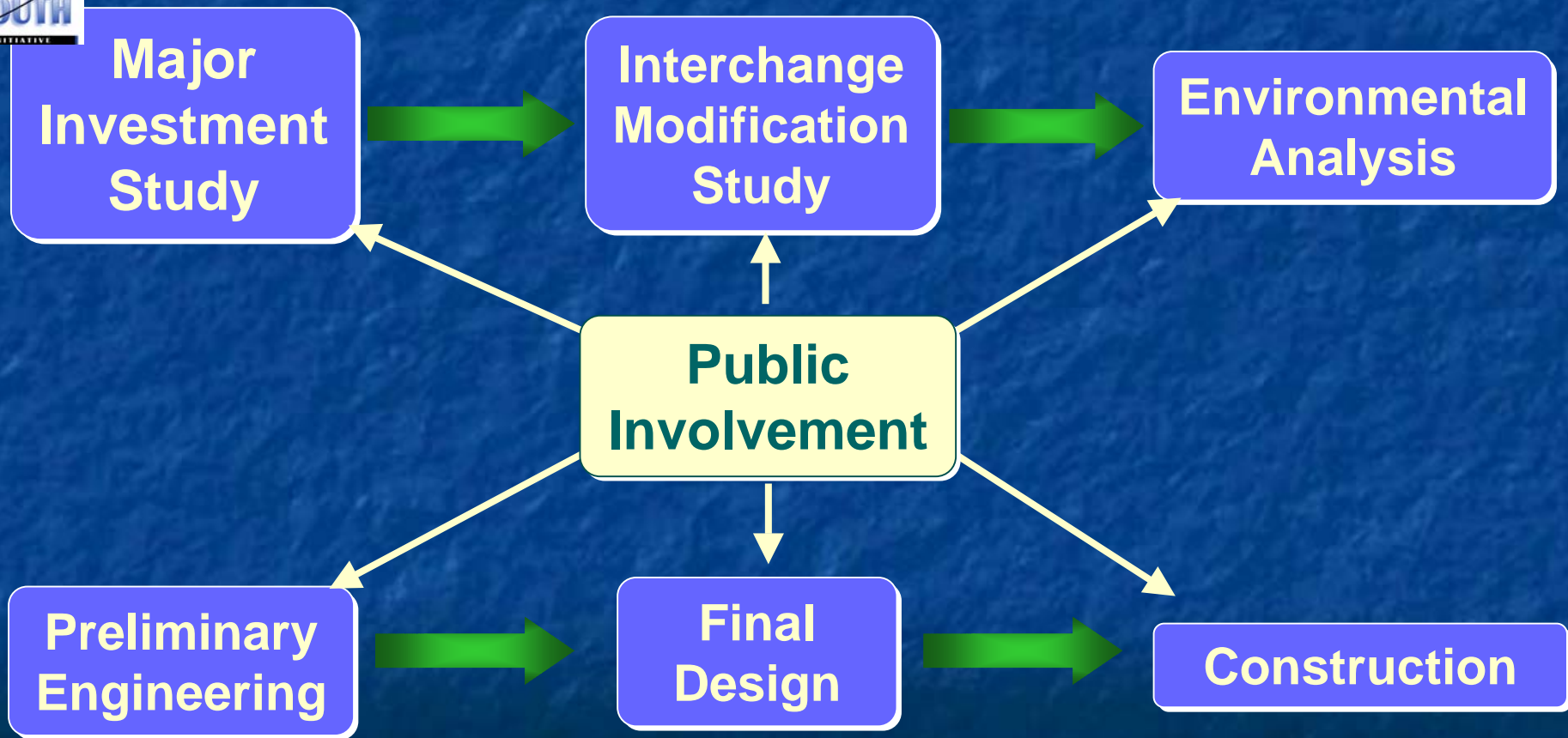
Planning for Major Transportation Investments



How did this Project Begin?

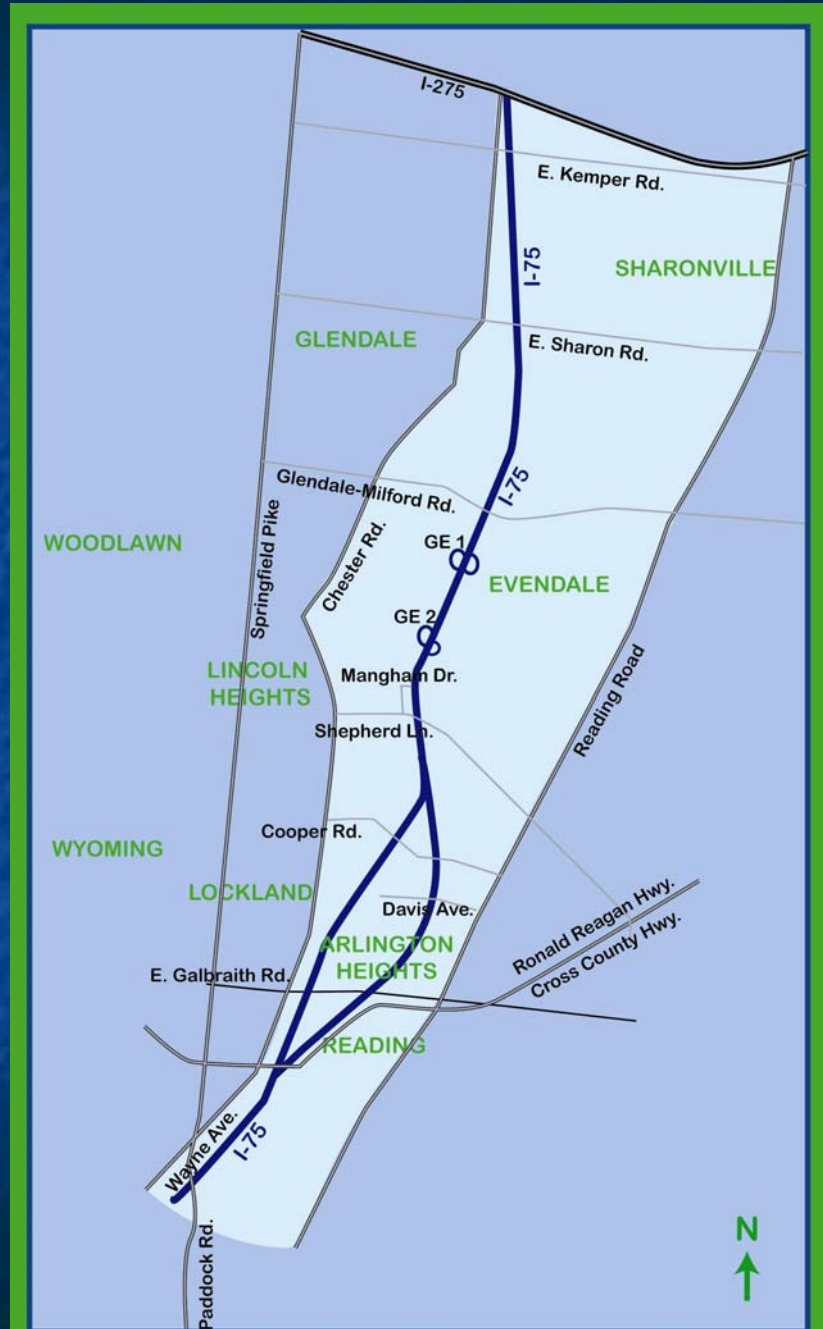
- Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments – Your Metropolitan Planning Organization

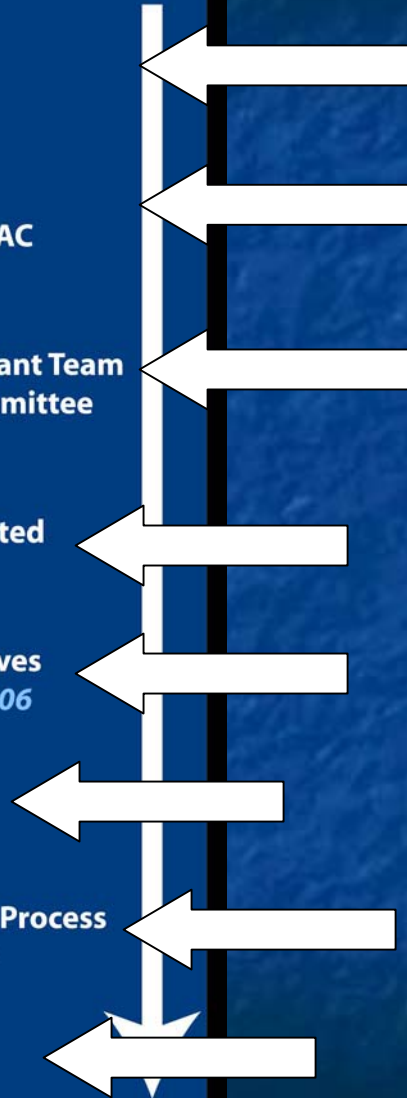
